Example 1: Translate into mathematical expressions. (a) The sum of 6 and twice a number; Solution: The phrase "twice a number" translates into two times the number, or $2x$. (Think about it twice the number 8 would be $2 \cdot 8 = 16$.) The word "sum" indicates that you should add 6 and $2x$ together to get a final
