The introduction for a short story should always be juicy... It should give the reader enough incentive to go on. Oftentimes, the reader asks herself "What is in it for me?" It is your job, as the writer, to answer that question. Whether or not she will proceed with reading your story depends on how well you answer that question.

How to Write Juicy Short-Story Introductions ...

The short story is usually concerned with a single effect conveyed in only one or a few significant episodes or scenes. The form encourages economy of setting, concise narrative, and the omission of a complex plot; character is disclosed in action and dramatic encounter but is seldom fully developed. Despite its relatively limited scope, though, a short story is often judged by its ability to ...

A short story incorporates the traditional plot structure of rising action, a climactic event and falling action, but compresses the events so it can be read in one sitting. Ways to Introduce a Short Story to High School Students ...

The short story genre is well suited to experimentation in prose writing style and form, but most short story authors still work to create a distinct mood using classic literary devices (point of view, imagery, foreshadowing, metaphor, diction/word choice, tone, and sentence structure).

Short Story Elements: Characters Characters are the actors in a story's plot. They can be people, animals, or whatever the writer chooses. The protagonist is the main character. The antagonist is in conflict with the main character.

Introduction To The Short Story

Short stories often begin in medias res, a Latin phrase meaning "in the middle of things," introducing the main conflict immediately without much backstory. For example, the exposition in Flannery O'Connor's "A Good Man is Hard to Find" reveals that the family in the story is going on a trip to Georgia and that the grandmother opposes the ...
